Thorsten Haeser to become Chief Commercial Officer at Hapag-Lloyd

Executive Board of Hapag-Lloyd to have four members in future

The Supervisory Board of Hapag-Lloyd AG has appointed Thorsten Haeser (47) as a new Executive Board member. Haeser will be in charge of Hapag-Lloyd's global sales activities as Chief Commercial Officer (CCO). The law graduate is currently Managing Director of Versatel GmbH, a company owned by United Internet AG. Prior to that, he held various management positions at Sixt AG, Telefonica O2 and VIAG Interkom.
